We are planning on launching a new program, the Harford County version of *It's Academic*, in September. Pre-production planning begins in June. The goal is to air a live, monthly program during the academic school year.

#### **New Business**

#### **Business Plan FY26**

Kelly presented the FY26 Business Plan. The goals are the same as our FY25 Business Plan, with the exception of new capital items. Our goal is to purchase closed captioning equipment for our TV channel using funds from the foundation. We would also like to purchase new lights for our studio.
